## Educational Standards

Our Community Based Services Program offers case management services to children, youth, and families residing in New York City and Lower Hudson Valley.

The primary goal is to prevent psychiatric hospitalizations leading to the separation of families by addressing the multiple stressors impacting their lives.



#### Targeted Case Management
