FFC Programs

Our Family Foster Care Programs provide a child with a safe and loving home that promotes growth and development. They also enable a child to maximize their fullest potential.

Our goal is that every child achieves permanency via reunification with their parents, relatives, friends, and/or adoption.

We recognize that the children placed in our care and the families we serve have experienced intense trauma and we are here to support and guide them through this difficult time. We provide extensive training to both staff and foster parents to support them every step of the way.

We take great pride in our work and in our unwavering commitment to the success of the children and families we serve.

Adoption Program

Sometimes children cannot be reunited with their parents. In such cases, adoption is an option that provides a child with a permanent home. Many of our foster parents go on to adopt the child who has been in their care.



Treatment Family Foster Care Program

TFFC is a family-based alternative for children ages 7 to 21 years of age, who would otherwise be placed in a higher level of care. The program serves children with moderate to severe emotional and behavioral issues whose needs can be met in a family setting. We offer specialized training and support to enable our TFFC foster parents to be successful.
